Research

Research and technological development (RTD) activities are essential elements in the functioning of industrialised countries. In general terms, the quality and relevance of RTD contributes to the individual and collective well-being of citizens. It fosters company competitiveness and employment and is essential in promoting consumer and environmental protection.

High level research is increasingly complex, interdisciplinary and costly. This is why the role of the European Union in promoting research activities is vital in that it can mobilise sufficient human and financial resources.

Promoting sustainable fisheries

In addition to being an important source of food to the European Union, the fishery sector also represents a vital source of employment to many coastal areas in the EU. Now that technological developments have done much to maximise catches there is some concern on the sustainability of these resources. But managing the diverse marine resources that the sector depends upon is a complex task. In this respect, research efforts can help ensure the continued productivity of the sector and provide crucial information necessary to properly manage living marine resources.

Decisions on fisheries management are increasingly based on information stemming from research, which is why such research needs a solid basis in science. Since the relevance and effectiveness of the measures that are taken under the Common Fisheries Policy (CFP) depend to a large extent on the quality and timeliness of the scientific advice on which they are based, the European Union has been actively promoting fisheries research projects through its research programmes. Preparation and Submission of Proposals (EPSS)

Online Submission

The recommended method in FP7 is ELECTRONIC ONLINE PROPOSAL PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION. The Electronic Proposal Submission Service (EPSS) is an internet-based application providing a secure work space for a consortium to prepare and submit a proposal jointly. Access requires only a standard web browser, no special software has to be installed on the users' computers. For all details see the [EPSS User Manual \(PDF\)](#) and the [EPSS Online Frequently Asked Questions \(FAQ\)](#).

N.B. Please note that after 5th May 2008 for all newly published calls you will be able to use your Participant Identification Code (PIC) in your electronic proposal preparation and submission. However for calls already open for proposal submission this may vary case-by-case. For more information please go to the section 'Register your organisation (URF)'.

N.B. You should read the call fiche, work programme and guide for applicants for the call you are interested in prior to using the EPSS.

The European Union and the Republic of India benefit from a longstanding relationship going back to the early 1960s. The Joint Political Statement of 1993 and the [1994 Co-operation Agreement](#), which is the current legislative framework for cooperation, opened the door to a broad political dialogue, which evolves through annual [Summits](#), regular ministerial and expert level meetings.

In 2004 India became one of the EU's "Strategic Partners" ([Joint Press Statement](#)). Since 2005, the [Joint Action Plan](#) [97 KB] which was revised in 2008, is helping to realise the full potential of this partnership in key areas of interest for India and the EU. Current efforts are centered on: ongoing negotiations for a trade and investment agreement; finalization of ongoing transport negotiations (civil aviation and maritime transport) and implementation of the joint work programme on climate change adopted at the last Summit in 2008.

The [Country Strategy Paper for India 2007-2013](#) [447 KB] (€470 million in total – a yearly average of €67 million) concentrates EU funds on health, education and the implementation of the Joint Action Plan.
