#### About the Common Fisheries Policy

#### Research

Research and technological development (RTD) activities are essential elements in the functioning of industrialised countries. In general terms, the quality and relevance of RTD contributes to the individual and collective well-being of citizens. It fosters company competitiveness and employment and is essential in promoting consumer and environmental protection.

High level research is increasingly complex, interdisciplinary and costly. This is why the role of the European Union in promoting research activities is vital in that it can mobilise sufficient human and financial resources.

#### Promoting sustainable fisheries

In addition to being an important source of food to the European Union, the fishery sector also represents a vital source of employment to many coastal areas in the EU. Now that technological developments have done much to maximise catches there is some concern on the sustainability of these resources. But managing the diverse marine resources that the sector depends upon is a complex task. In this respect, research efforts can help ensure the continued productivity of the sector and provide crucial information necessary to properly manage living marine resources.

Decisions on fisheries management are increasingly based on information stemming from research, which is why such research needs a solid basis in science. Since the relevance and effectiveness of the measures that are taken under the Common Fisheries Policy (CFP) depend to a large extent on the quality and timeliness of the scientific advice on which they are based, the European Union has been actively promoting fisheries research projects through its research programmes. #### Cooperation

The specific programme on 'Cooperation' supports all types of research activities carried out by different research bodies in transnational cooperation and aims to gain or consolidate leadership in key scientific and technology areas.

FP7 allocates EUR 32 413 million to the Cooperation programme. The budget will be devoted to supporting cooperation between universities, industry, research centres and public authorities throughout the EU and beyond.

Euratom

The Seventh Framework Programme of the **European Atomic Energy Community** (Euratom) for nuclear research and training activities (2007 to 2011)

Furnnean Research Area

Euratom energy research activities are carried out under the treaty with the same name, which in 1957 established the European Atomic Energy Community (Euratom). Euratom is legally separated from the European Community (EC) and has its own Framework Research Programme, however managed by the common Community institutions.

Although Member States retain most competencies in energy policy, whether based on nuclear or other sources, the Euratom Treaty has achieved an important degree of harmonisation at European level. It legislates for a number of specific tasks for the




The Joint Research Centre (JRC) provides customer-driven scientific and technical support to the conception, development, implementation and monitoring of EU policies. As the research 'arm' of the European Commission, the JRC is a reference centre for science and technology issues that serves the interests of the Member States while at the same time remaining independent of special interests.

The Commission's proposals for the Seventh Framework Programme (FP7) aim to reinforce the JRC's customer-driven orientation and its already strong connections with the scientific community by taking an integrated approach to its main task, the provision of scientific and technological support to policies.
